NOTICE OF MOTION

RE: Reconsideration of "Land Use Bylaw Housekeeping Amendments, IP2025-0251"

WHEREAS Council considered Item 7.3.1, "Land Use Bylaw Housekeeping Amendments, IP2025-0251" at the 2025 May 6 Public Hearing Meeting of Council.

WHEREAS there are unintended consequences resulting from a defeated motion to give three readings to Proposed Bylaw 44P2025, including the inability to approve Child Care Services in existing Low Density Residential Areas through an updated Land Use Bylaw or a Direct Control district.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that Council:

- 1. Reconsider its decision with respect to Recommendations 1 and 2 of Item 7.3.1 "Land Use Bylaw Housekeeping Amendments, IP2025-0251" from the 2025 May 6 Public Hearing Meeting of Council;
- 2. Give three readings to Proposed Bylaw 44P2025, amendments to the Land Use Bylaw 1P2007 (Attachment 2), as amended; and
- 3. Adopt, by resolution, the proposed amendments to the Child Care Service Policy and Development Guidelines (Attachment 3).
