Street Name in Belvedere (Ward 9), SN2025-0002

RECOMMENDATION:

That Calgary Planning Commission recommend that Council:

Adopt, by resolution, the proposed street name of Eston.

RECOMMENDATION OF THE CALGARY PLANNING COMMISSION, 2025 APRIL 10:

That Council adopt, by resolution, the proposed street name of Eston.

HIGHLIGHTS

- This application proposes a new street name in the community of Belvedere.
- Administration recommends approval of the proposal as it complies with the Municipal Naming, Sponsorship and Naming Rights Policy and *Belvedere Area Structure Plan* (ASP).
- What does this mean to Calgarians? Municipal naming of streets plays an important role in simple and unambiguous identification for location and navigation within Calgary.
- Why does this matter? The proposal will assist citizens and emergency services operators with navigation to and within the developing community of Belvedere.
- The application is associated with a land use and outline plan application, LOC2024-0321.
- There is no previous Council direction regarding this proposal.

DISCUSSION

This application, in the southeast community of Belvedere, was submitted by O2 Planning & Design, on behalf of the landowners, Minto Communities, on 2025 February 03.

The subject land is in southeast Calgary, south of 17 Avenue SE and west of 84 Street SE, east of Stoney Trail SE. Location maps are provided in Attachment 1.

A concurrent land use amendment and outline plan application (LOC2024-0321, Attachment 2) for a residential neighbourhood has been submitted and is now under review.

The proposed street name was selected to complement the adjacent commercial area north of the property known as East Hills Shopping Centre. The street naming of 'Eston' was selected to maintain a similar naming convention. More information can be found in the Application's Submission in Attachment 3.

Administration has considered the relevant planning issues and public feedback specific to the application and has determined the proposal to be appropriate.
