New Facility Plan

- \$60M Feasibility Study high probable cost
- \$14.5M City of Calgary (commitment)
- \$15M Capital Campaign (philanthropy, corporate, private)
- \$5M \$10M Federal (program specific)
- \$14.5M Government of Alberta (to match the City)
 - * Not successful in 2025 Budget resubmit for 2026
 - * Immediate need of \$2M for Detailed Design Work to bring project shovel ready. Working with the City of Calgary, Heritage Canada, and Calgary Airport Authority to have funds confirmed for the design phase 2026
- \$5.5M Calgary Airport Authority (tenant value with longterm in-kind land-use agreement that can leverage other funding sources)
