NOTICE OF MOTION

RE: Land Use Bylaw Housekeeping Amendments: Child Care Services

Sponsoring Member(s) of Council: Councillor Penner, Councillor Walcott, & Mayor Gondek

WHEREAS Council considered Item 7.3.1, "Land Use Bylaw Housekeeping Amendments, IP2025-0251" at the 2025 May 6 Public Hearing Meeting of Council.

WHEREAS there are unintended consequences resulting from a defeated motion to give three readings to Proposed Bylaw 44P2025, including the inability to approve Child Care Services in existing Low Density Residential Areas through an updated Land Use Bylaw or a Direct Control district.

WHEREAS Following the item failing on a tie, a reconsideration Notice of Motion was brought on May 27th with an amendment prepared for the motion to allow for council to vote on each item individually.

WHEREAS Council defeated the reconsideration.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that Council direct administration to:

1. Amend the Land Use Bylaw (IP2007) to allow a child-care service as a discretionary use in existing approved buildings in the low-density residential districts.

AND NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that Administration advertise and bring the bylaw updates direct to the September 9th, Public Hearing of Council.
