Commissioner Hawryluk	Reasons for Approval Commission reviewed this application prior to Council's approval of the Citywide Growth Strategy: Industrial Action Plan, IP2025-0538, on the 24th of June 2025. Commission discussed whether the proposed Direct Control District (based on the Industrial – General (I-G) District) was trying to act like a commercial District, which raised questions about whether this was an appropriate District for an industrial area. Now that Council has approved the Citywide Growth Strategy: Industrial Action Plan, in which Council directed Administration to look at which industrial areas might support a wider range of nonindustrial uses, this application should be more straightforward than it was during Commission's review. The strongest argument for the proposed Direct Control District's additional discretionary uses, building design and orientation regulations, and additional use rules under the based I-G District is that the Applicant intends to build a "building that can easily be converted to an industrial use should the Supermarket fail" (Attachment 4, page 1).
