Planning & Development Response to Councillor Sharp Regular Meeting of Council 2025 July 29

Development Permits

This is a response to the Administrative Inquiry submitted by Councillor Sharp at the 2025 April 29 Regular Meeting of Council.

- 1. Of the total of 269 development permit applications that were submitted in 2024 that would have previously required a land use amendment prior to proceeding with their development, how many development permit applications were approved by the Planning Department and how many were refused by the Planning Department?
 - From 2024 May 14 onward, 269 development permit applications were received by the City that would have previously required a land use amendment prior to citywide rezoning. Of these, a total of 172 permits have been approved. To date, no permits have been refused (some have been cancelled)
- 2. Of the total of 269 development permit applications that were submitted in 2024 that would have previously required a land use amendment prior to proceeding with their development, how many development permit applications were appealed at the Subdivision Appeal Board?
 - Our records show the Subdivision Appeal Board (SDAB) has received 16
 appeals in 2024 and 17 appeals in 2025 for RC-G zoned sites for a total of 33 to
 end of May 2025. A more comprehensive SDAB statistics and trends analysis is
 forthcoming from Administration that is scheduled to be published in early Q3 of
 this year.
- 3. Of the total of 269 development permit applications that were submitted in 2024 that would have previously required a land use amendment prior to proceeding with their development, how many development permit applications were in Bowness?
 - A total of 28 permits submitted between 2024 May 14 and 2024 December 31
 were located in the community of Bowness: 23 have been approved, and five are
 still being reviewed, with no decision made at the time of writing
