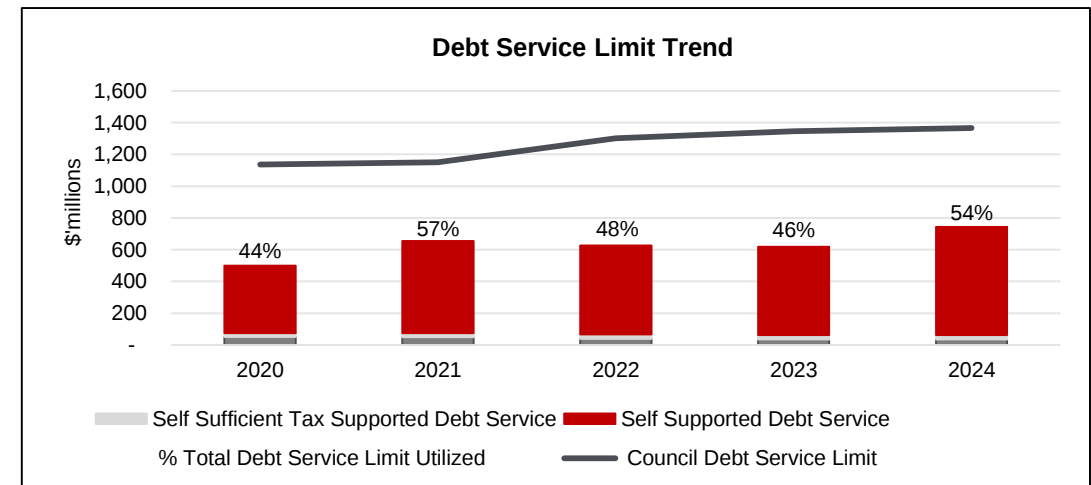
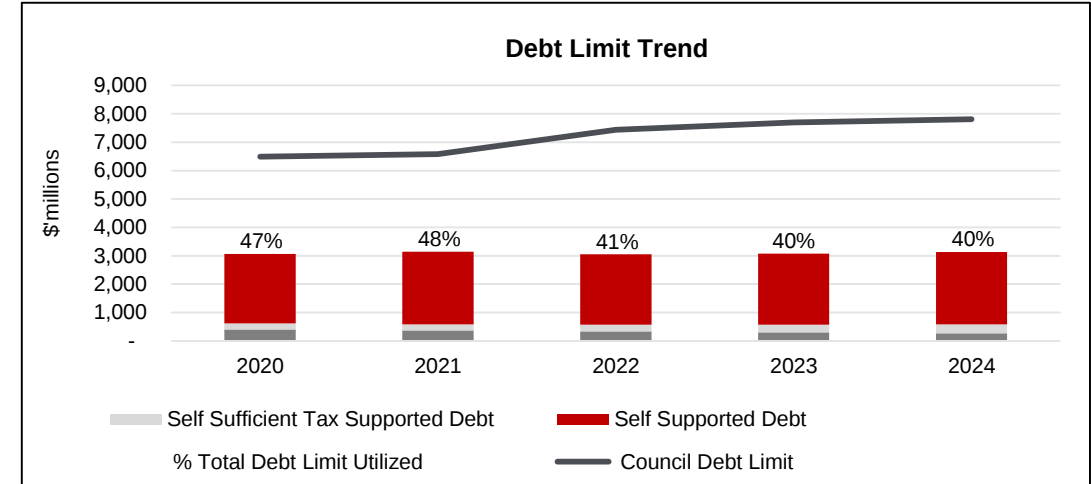
Debt Policy is legally required per The City of Calgary Charter with a public hearing component.
