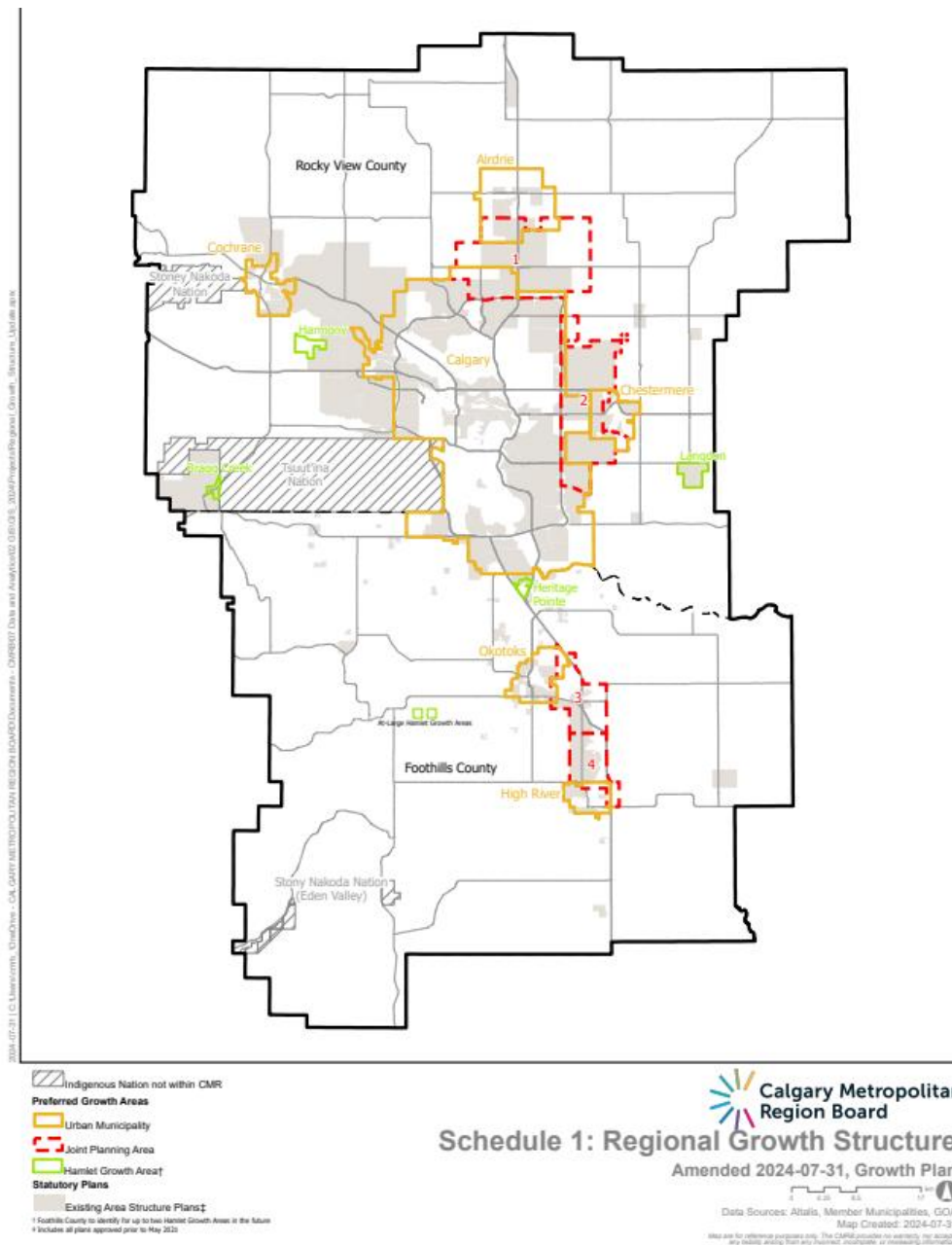


Background and Previous Council Direction
