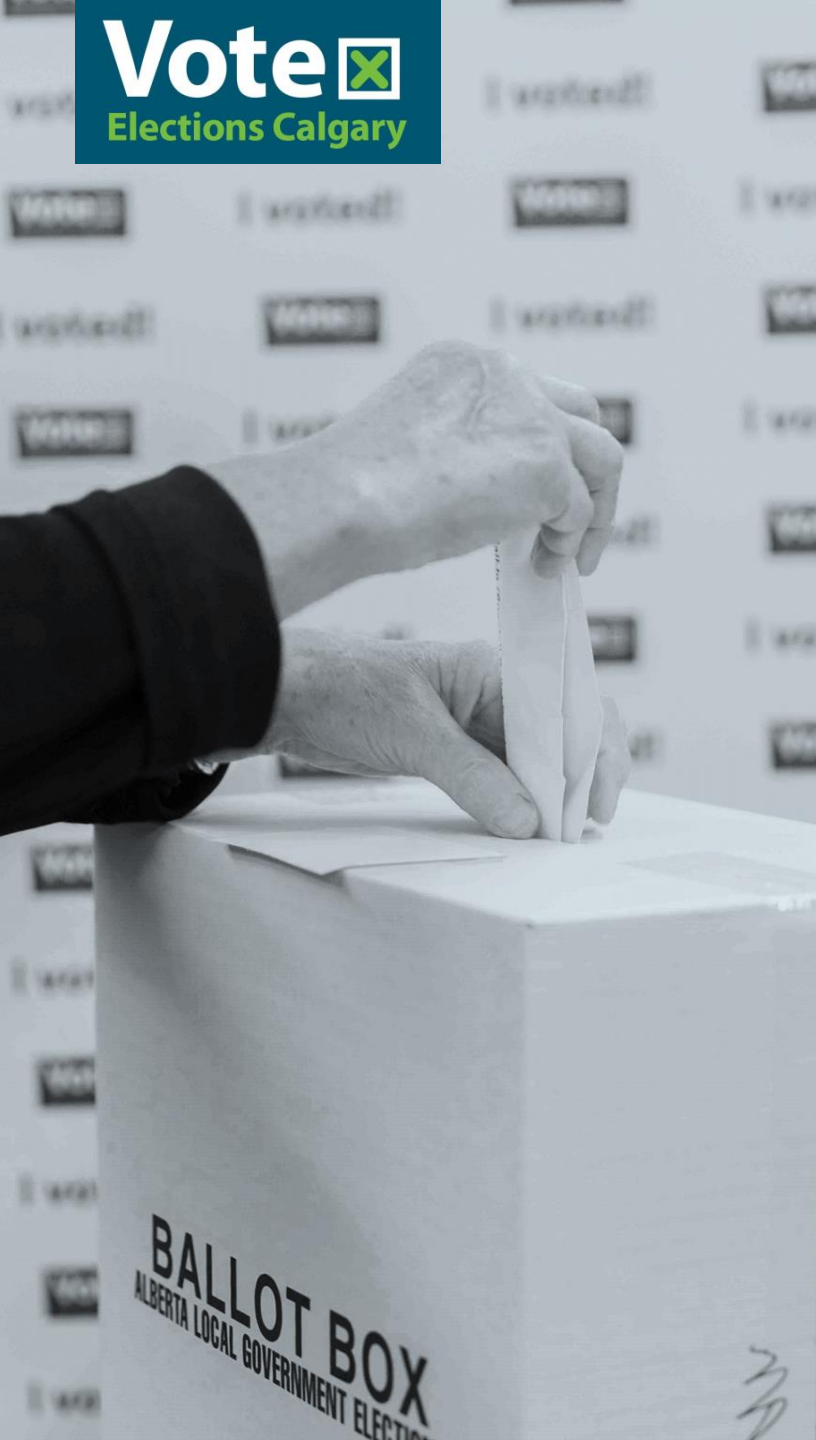




Repeal of Early Voting Hours Bylaw for Separate School Elections

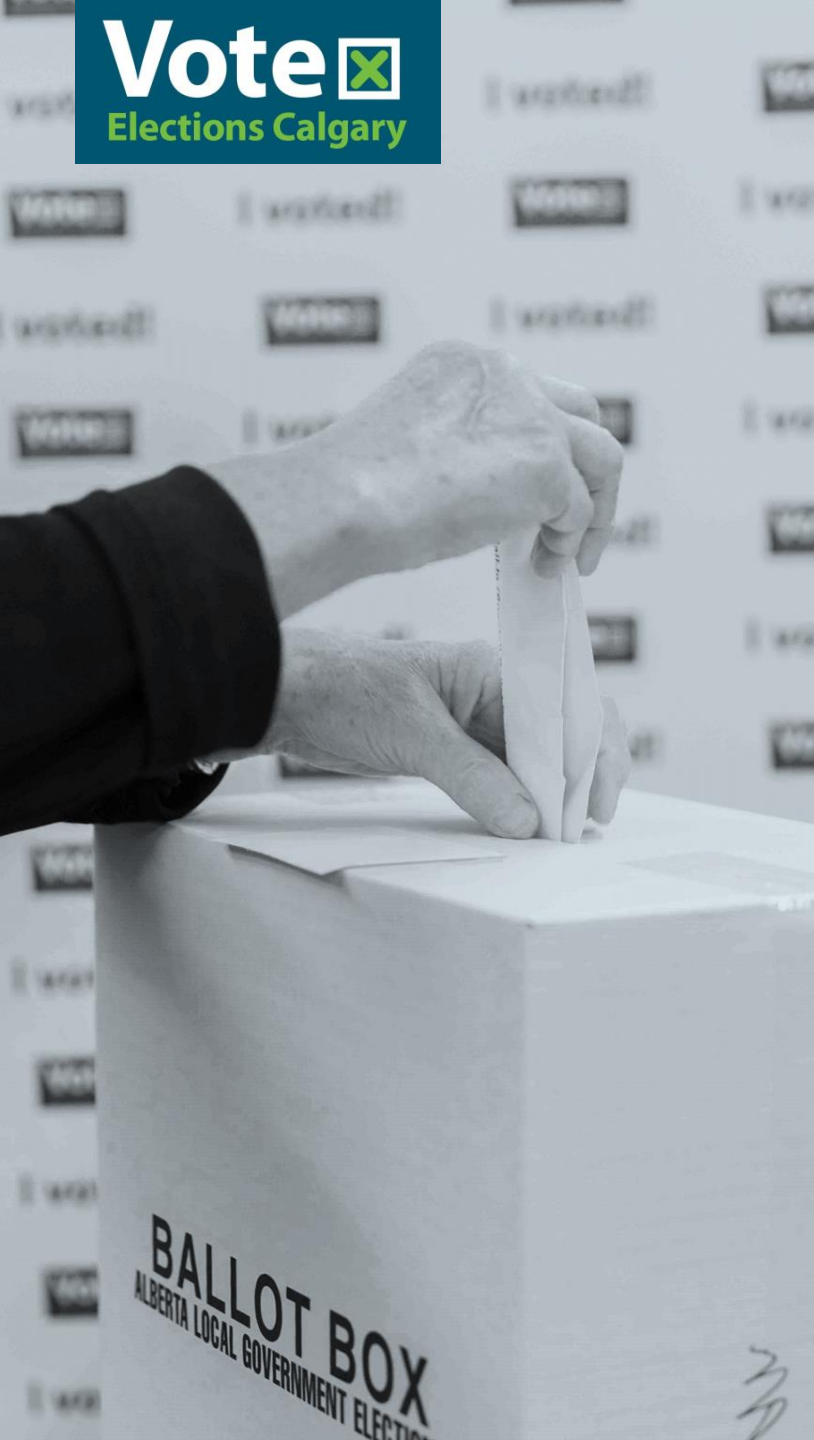
That Council give three readings to proposed Bylaw 34M2025 (Attachment 1) to repeal Bylaw 29M2007 (Attachment 2).

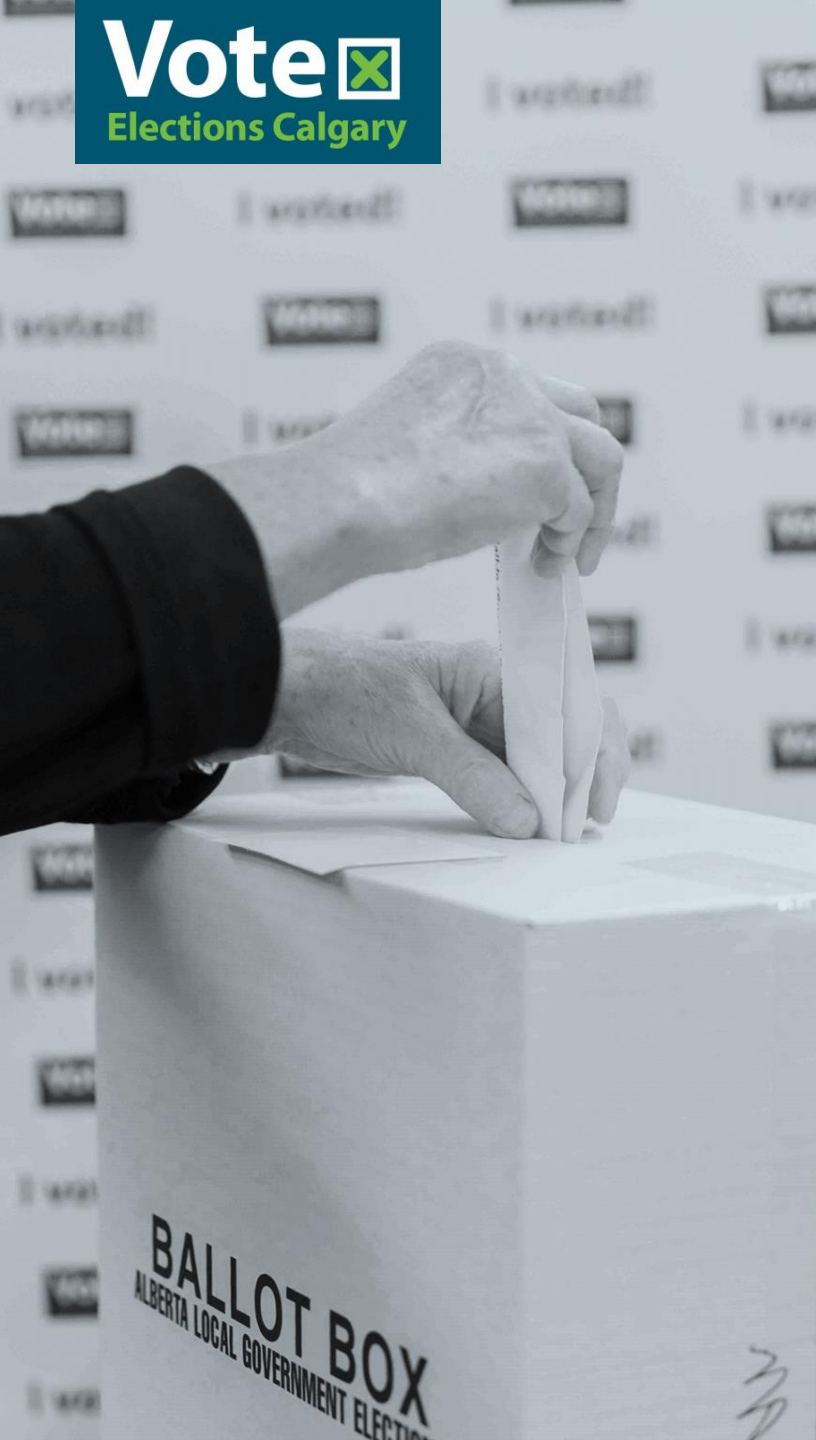
Highlights

- The City of Calgary is accountable to administer separate school elections.
- The separate school board jurisdiction includes parts of Calgary, Airdrie, Cochrane and Chestermere.
- Voting stations in Calgary to be open between 10 a.m. and 8 p.m. on Election Day.
- Voting stations may be open before 10 a.m. on Election Day where an elected authority passes a by-law before June 30.

Highlights

- Council or the separate school board may exercise authority to pass early voting hours bylaw.
- In past elections, early voting hours for separate school elections in Airdrie, Cochrane and Chestermere was authorized through Bylaw 29M2007.
- The separate school board passed Bylaw No. 191-2025 for 2025 General Election, making Bylaw 29M2007 obsolete.
