

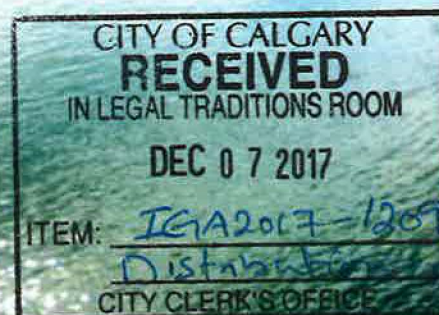

- Proposed Timeline

Canada

Proposed Cannabis Excise Tax:

- **The greater of 10% or 1\$ per gram**
- **+GST**
- **To be split 50/50 with Provinces**
- **No mention of Municipalities**

Proposed Approach to the Regulation of Cannabis:

- **Reduced Security Requirements for Federally Licenced Producers**
- **Potential for security clearance for “non-violent, lower-risk criminal activity”**
- **Administration is still reviewing**

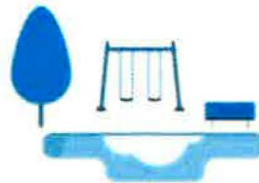

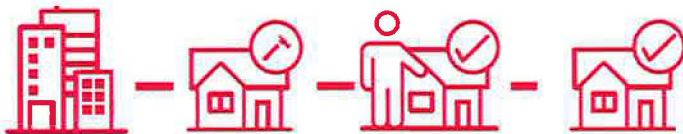

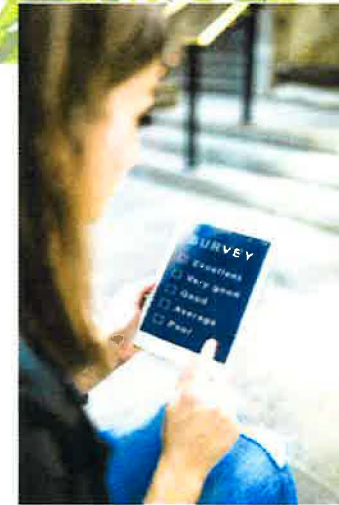
