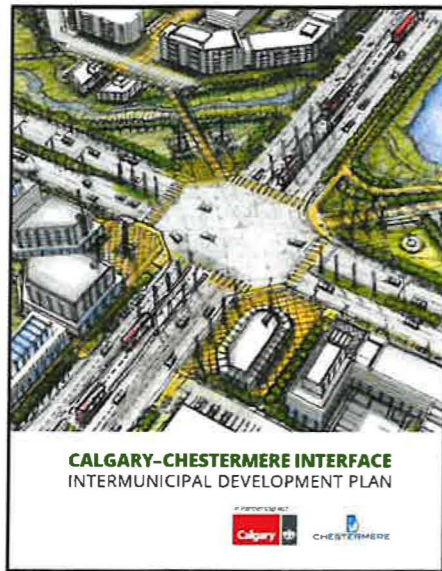

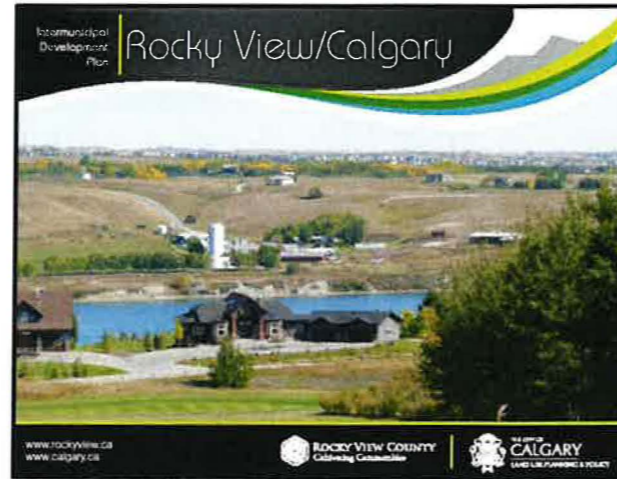

Intermunicipal Development Plans

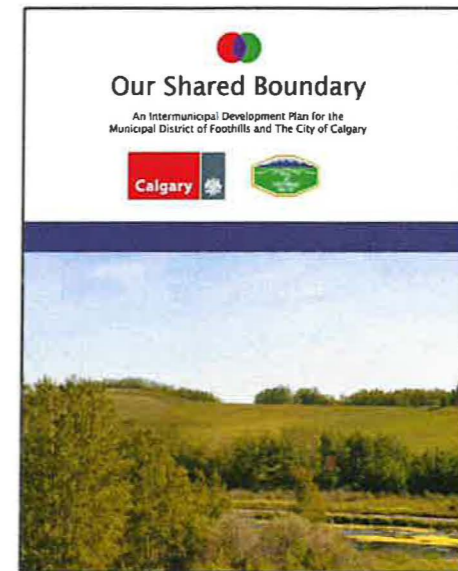
Calgary holds three existing **Intermunicipal Development Plans (IDP)** that need updating

Rocky View County (2012)

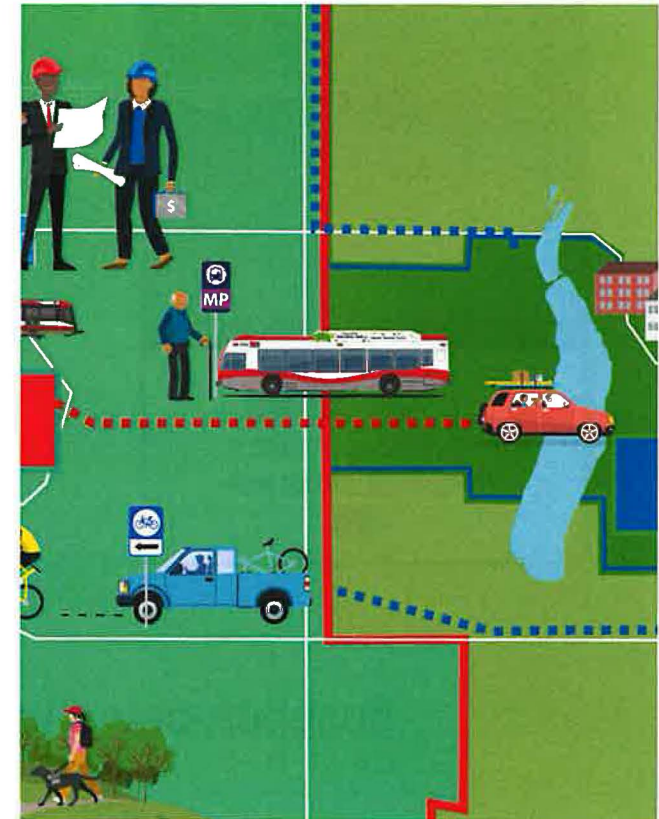


Foothills County (2017)

Intermunicipal Collaboration Frameworks

Calgary is required to develop three **Intermunicipal Collaboration Frameworks (ICF)** with adjacent municipalities

- ICFs are bi-lateral agreements on cooperative and efficient servicing delivery (transportation, water and wastewater, solid waste, emergency services, and recreation).
- ICFs address shared services, cost sharing arrangements, dispute resolution & governance.



Alberta Community Partnership (ACP) Grant

- Intermunicipal Collaboration Stream - \$200,000
- ACP Grant application coordination:
 - **Calgary** on behalf of **Chestermere**
 - **Rocky View County** on behalf of **Calgary**
 - **Chestermere** on behalf of **Rocky View County**
- Two Council resolutions are required (one as lead applicant and one as project partner)
