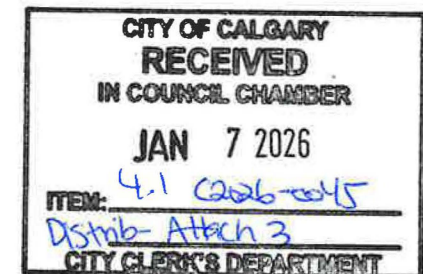

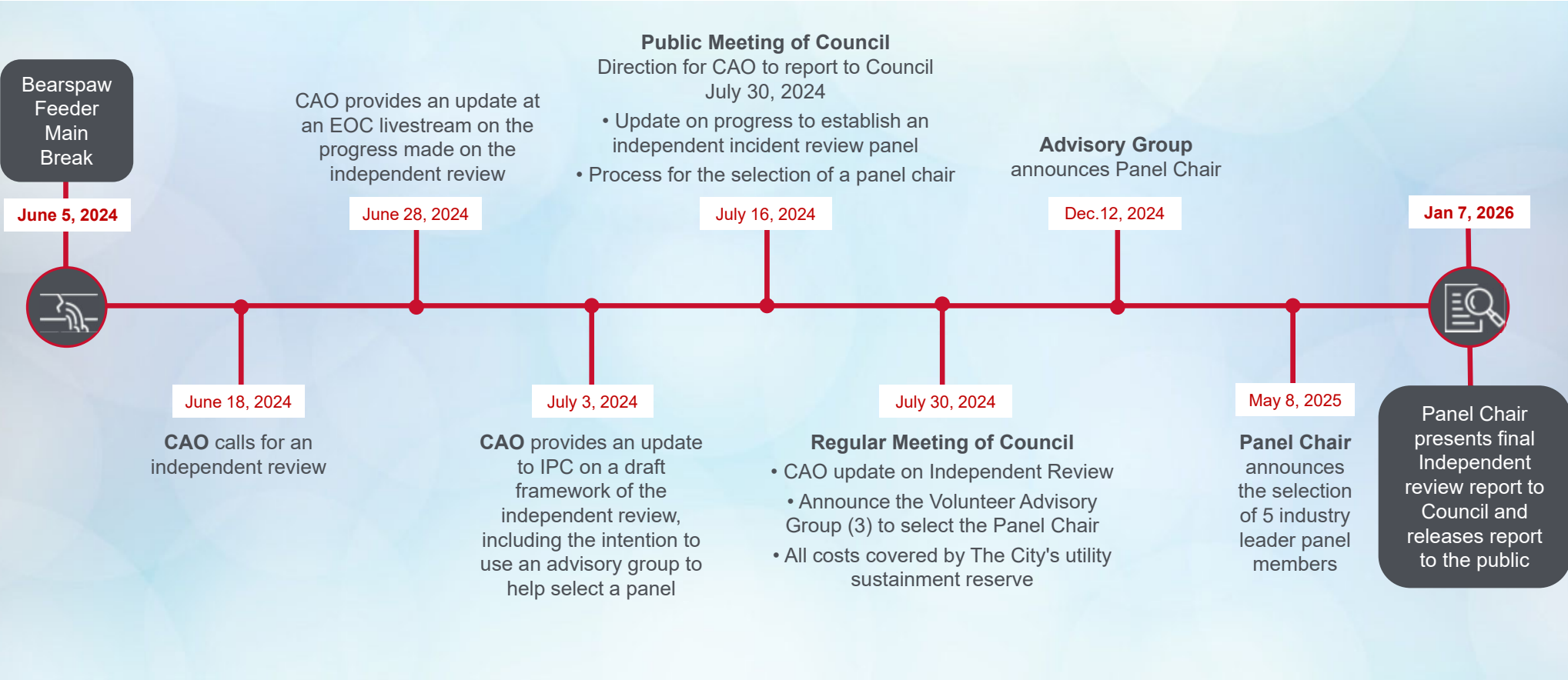


### That Council:

## Actions from Administration



**Establish an Implementation Governance Structure** to translate Council direction and recommendations into accountable, time-bound actions—prioritizing safety, system reliability, and public transparency.



**Report Back to Council** with a sequenced implementation plan, including immediate, short-term, and long-term actions, and clear performance measures.



**Publish Progress Updates** so Calgarians can see how the implementation plan is being adopted, with regular status reporting through Council and the City's communications channels.
