- A shared plan between The City of Calgary and Community Partners
- 17 Council-endorsed City-led Actions
- 15 Community-led Actions





What is happening in Calgary's Food System?

Opportunities:

- Increase in urban food production and local food consumption
- Economic opportunity for entrepreneurial food producers and large-scale agribusiness

Challenges:

- Increased household food insecurity due to loss of employment, precarious work and low wages
- Lack of affordable and suitable vacant land for food production

- Web-based Food Hub on Calgary.ca






Community Activity

- Portfolio analysis to identify emerging opportunities






