


LAS2015-35 Historic City Hall Rehabilitation Update and Project Plan

Background:

- Inaugurated in 1911
- Officially protected as a National, Provincial & Municipal historic site
- In response to significant deterioration in 2014,
 a rehabilitation project was initiated
- Expert rehabilitation team has been engaged.




Investigation Findings - Building Envelope

Stakeholder Engagement & Research

Communications

Three Accommodation Scenarios were analyzed according to Constructability, Benefits, Risks & Costs:

- 1) Rehabilitate with all tenants remaining in place throughout the project (not recommended)
- 2) Rehabilitate with partial tenancy throughout the project (not recommended)
- 3) Rehabilitate with all tenants relocated for the duration of the project (recommended & approved by COCC on Oct 15th)



Recommendation:

- That Land and Asset Strategy Committee recommend that Council approve the Historic City Hall Rehabilitation Project costs as set out in Attachment 2; and
- 2) Attachments 1, 2 and 4 remain confidential under Sections 23(1)(b), 24(1)(a), 24(1)(g) and 25(1)(b) of the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act until the Historic City Hall project is fully tendered.1
