

### **Integrated Watershed Management**






### Integrated levels of flood mitigation



#### **City Projects:**

- Reinforce existing barriers
- New local barriers underway
  - West Eau Claire
  - Centre Street
  - Montgomery
  - Heritage Drive
  - Bonnybrook
- Drainage improvements
- Emergency response
- Gravel bar reshaping

#### Others:

- TransAlta Operating Agreement
- Springbank Reservoir Project

#### Remaining risk is primarily on the Bow River.


• SR1 = 2013 reduced to ~640cms


+ Glenmore gates = 2013 reduced to ~170 cms (mitigates event similar to 2013)

- Some opposition from outside stakeholders






- New Upstream Reservoir + TransAlta agreement = reduces 2013 to ~1200 cms
  - + Complementary barriers = mitigates event similar to 2013




