Roles and responsibilities

City Council

- Approve policy
- Governance

Emergency Management Committee

- Advise Council on development of emergency plans and programs

Local Emergency Committee

- Declare State of Local Emergency

CS&PS General Manager

- Align resources to support Council priorities
- Appoint Director

Director

- Coordinate emergency services and resources during emergency
- Prepare and coordinate emergency plans and programs

CEMA

- Delivery of emergency plans and programs
- Member and partner coordination

Future of emergency management

- Advance preparedness of City, communities and citizens
- Leverage existing relationships and continue to build new partnerships
- Secure provincial and federal support for mitigation and preparedness
