ADMINISTRATION RECOMMENDATION(S)

That the Priorities and Finance Committee recommend that Council:

- 1. Accept the resignation of Mr. Mark lantkow as a Member with Disability on the Advisory Committee on Accessibility, and that he be thanked for his service; and
- Direct that the position remain vacant until the 2015 Organizational Meeting of Council when Council will make regular appointments to the Advisory Committee on Accessibility.

PREVIOUS COUNCIL DIRECTION / POLICY

At the 2012 October 22 Organizational Meeting of Council, Council appointed Mr. lantkow as a Member with Disability to the Advisory Committee on Accessibility for a three-year term expiring at the 2015 Organizational Meeting of Council.

At the 2009 October 19 Organizational Meeting of Council, Council appointed Mr. Iantkow as a Member-at-Large to the Advisory Committee on Accessibility for a three-year term expiring at the 2012 Organizational Meeting of Council.

BACKGROUND

The Advisory Committee on Accessibility makes recommendations to Council with respect to policy issues, the accessibility of municipal properties, information and services for persons with disabilities and acts as a resource to Council and City Administration in addressing accessibility issues. The composition, appointment term and quorum of the Advisory Committee on Accessibility are detailed in the Attachment.

INVESTIGATION: ALTERNATIVES AND ANALYSIS

On 2015 March 16, the City Clerk's Office received notification that Mr. lantkow tendered his resignation, effective 2015 March 15, creating a vacancy on the Advisory Committee on Accessibility. Mr. lantkow's appointment term was set to expire at the 2015 Organizational Meeting of Council.

The Council policy on the *Appointment of Council, Administration and Citizens to Agencies and Establishment of Council Agencies (CC003)* provides that appointments outside of the Organizational Meeting of Council may be for the term remaining in the vacancy or until the next Organizational Meeting as determined by Council. Accordingly, filling the vacancy at this time would mean appointing a new member for a five month term set to expire on 2015 October 19. Alternatively, the appointment could be deferred until the 2015 Organizational Meeting of Council, at which time Council could appoint a new member for the full two-year term in accordance with the Advisory Committee on Accessibility's Terms of Reference.
