#### Action examples to support this Priority:

- · Implement rapid transit routes
- Launch the Green Line Transitway

- Implement and evaluate Centre City Cycle Track
- Plan and implement pedestrian strategy

We steward our air, land and water, while encouraging healthy lifestyles for all Calgarians.


Action examples to support this Priority:

- · Ensure all communities can access quality open space


