- 2017 September 11, Council directed Admir intrate CITY CLERK'S OFFICE
  - Continue negotiations of a new Master Servicing Agreement (MSA) with Rocky View County (RVC)
  - Return to Council regarding servicing Elbow Valley West (EVW) once it was confirmed The City had sufficient capacity
- 2018 February 26
  - Council approved a new Policy on Regional Water, Wastewater and Stormwater Serviing (CP2018-01) to replace policy UEP004



## Background

- The City has an agreement with RVC for wastewater servicing along Highway 8 Corridor.
  - · Calgary is negotiating a new MSA with RVC.
- EVW is comprised of approximately 120 lots.
  - Wastewater in EVW is hauled to Calgary for treatment
- RVC has requested that Calgary extend wastewater servicing to EVW

## Investigation

- The new regional servicing policy (CP2018-01) allows Council to consider this request.
- The risk to Calgary's source water for this development is negligible.
- The City has capacity to service EVW following RVC improvements to system inflow and infiltration.
- Approving wastewater servicing may be premature given that the CMRB is developing Growth and Servicing Plans.
