Background

- The City has an agreement with RVC for wastewater servicing along Highway 8 Corridor.
 - Calgary is negotiating a new MSA with RVC.
- EVW is comprised of approximately 120 lots.
 - Wastewater in EVW is hauled to Calgary for treatment
- RVC has requested that Calgary extend wastewater servicing to EVW



Investigation

- The new regional servicing policy (CP2018-01) allows Council to consider this request.
- The risk to Calgary's source water for this development is negligible.
- The City has capacity to service EVW following RVC improvements to system inflow and infiltration.
- Approving wastewater servicing may be premature given that the CMRB is developing Growth and Servicing Plans.



Administration Recommendations

That the Intergovernmental Affairs Committee recommend that Council:

1. Approve wastewater servicing to Elbow Valley West and direct Administration to execute a new Master Servicing Agreement with Rocky View County for the provisions of wastewater servicing based on the proposed service area in Attachment 1 and term sheet in Attachment 2.
