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Council Direction

- September 11, 2017 Notice of Motion NM2017-34
 - Encourage increased energy efficiency in low density residential housing through:
 - Develop a standalone permit process for exterior insulation retrofits to existing houses
 - Explore permitting lot coverage to exceed the current Land Use Bylaw maximums where the lot coverage is increased due to exterior insulation installation
 - Report back to Council by Q2 2018

Recommendations by Administration


- Revise Land Use Bylaw to exempt additional insulation from lot coverage calculation to avoid unnecessary Development Permit applications/relaxations
- Revise Land Use Bylaw to exempt up to 30 cm of exterior insulation to extend into any required setback are to avoid unnecessary Development Permit applications/relaxations
- Ensure buildings remain safe by reviewing proposed Building Permit applications through plans examination and inspections




Side Yard of Typical Retrofit
