



#### Infrastructure / Operations Resiliency (Att. 2)

Corporate infrastructure and operations

- Facilitate normal day-to-day operations
- Supports resilience to future events; will help reduce recovery efforts
- Contribute to staff well being
- Can be completed in 2014



#### **Provincial Mitigation Resiliency Submission (Att. 3)**

- Meets Provincial criteria
- Proposed projects for hazard mitigation and resiliencies related to watershed
- Prioritization process to occur with Province
- Funding decisions expected Q3 of this year
