Stage 1

- Mega project \$4.65 billion
- The City's largest project to date
- 3.5 X larger than the second largest (West LRT cost of \$1.3 billion)
- 14 stations
- 3 park and ride facilities ~ 800 stalls
- 1 parking structure ~1200 stalls
- 1 light rail vehicle (LRV) Maintenance and Storage Facility



Extension to the In Service Date (ISD) Cost
= \$2.5M/Calendar day
