1.	Telecommunications company advises Development & Building Approvals of potential tower location.	1.	Telecommunications company makes inquiry about City-owned land with Corporate Properties & Buildings.
2.	Development & Building Approvals advises Telecommunications company of public consultation requirement.	2.	Corporate Properties & Buildings reviews site investigation evidence and circulates inquiry to City business units to determine site availability.
3.	Telecommunications company holds public meeting.	3.	City-owned land determined to be available.
4.	Telecommunications company responds to public concerns.	4.	Telecommunications company agrees to City licence of occupation terms and conditions.
		5.	Corporate Properties & Buildings issues a Letter of Authorization, allowing the Telecommunications company to include City-owned land in a formal planning submission to Development & Building Approvals.
5.	Telecommunications company makes a formal submission (that includes the land owner's <i>Letter of Authorization</i>) to Development & Building Approvals.		
6.	Development & Building Approvals reviews and may issue <i>Letter of Concurrence</i> .	×	
		6.	Development & Building Approvals provides Corporate Properties & Buildings with a copy of the <i>Letter of Concurrence</i> , and Corporate Properties & Buildings enters into a licence of occupation agreement with the Telecommunications company.
