The Calgary Heritage Authority (CHA) requests that City Council assist the CHA in presenting four heritage plaques at either the January 27 or February 25 meeting of City Council. On behalf of LUPP, I am pleased to support this request.

The CHA recognizes sites of heritage value through a program that places interpretive plaques on heritage resources. CHA Chair, Scott Jolliffe advises that the CHA's subject matter this year is bridges. The bridges theme was agreed upon prior to the 2013 flood, and thankfully all of the recognized structures survived the flood intact to receive their plaques.
