Office Consolidation

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Municipal Government Act Alignment

- Requires notification.
- Form and manner of notification must be in the Land Use Bylaw.

Proposed Land Use Bylaw Amendments

- Notification on:
 - ✓ Complete/incomplete applications;
 - $\checkmark\,$ Timelines for submitting information; and
 - ✓ Deemed refusal; if information is not submitted within the timelines.



Inventory of Historic Resources Name Change

- Inventory of Potential Heritage Sites changing to Inventory of Evaluated Historic Resources.
- Clerical change for consistency.

Building Industry and Land Development and Building Owners & Managers Association

Proposed Land Use Bylaw amendments facilitate the required amendments to align with the *Municipal Government Act*.
