

**PROPOSED WORDING FOR A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF CALGARY TO AMEND
THE MUNICIPAL RIGHTS-OF-WAY BYLAW 17M2016**

1. Bylaw 17M2016, the Municipal Rights-of-Way Bylaw, is amended.
2. In Section 55, delete the following:

“, whether temporary or permanent,”
3. Delete Section 57 in its entirety and substitute the following:

“Requirements for Temporary Service Drops

57. *A utility provider must provide written notification to The City of the utility provider’s placement of a temporary service drop no later than 5 business days after the installation of the equipment. The notification must be submitted in the electronic format set by The City in its web interface with utility providers, and include the specific location of the temporary service drop and the date on which the temporary service drop was placed.”*
4. This bylaw comes into force on the day that it is passed.
