In accordance with the *Municipal Government Act*, the Assessment business unit annually collects information about properties in order to prepare assessments. Our preliminary analysis indicates that the above referenced property may have been physically affected by the flood.

If you have any questions or wish to discuss the status of your property before the 2014 assessments are established, please contact Assessment at 403-268-2888 between Oct. 7 and Nov. 7, 2013 to arrange an information exchange appointment.

The City of Calgary's 2014 Property Assessment Notices will be mailed on January 3, 2014. Following the Notice mailing, you will have the opportunity to review and, if necessary, inquire about your 2014 assessment during the 60-day Customer Review Period from January 3 – March 4, 2014. If any information about your property needs to be changed or updated, we encourage you to contact us during the Customer Review Period.
