• 2 health care practitioners (e. g., medical doctor, occupational

or physical therapist, rehabilitation specialist)

TERM • 1 year term

• A member may serve a maximum of six consecutive years.

 Despite the above, a member may serve until his or her successor is appointed. The service of a member beyond the appointed term shall not count toward the limit on the length of service set out above if the additional service is six months or less.

• When an appointment is made to fill a member vacancy:

 If the balance of the term to be served is six months or less, that service shall not count toward the limit on the length of service; and

 If the balance of the term to be served is more than six months, that service shall count toward the limit on the length of service.

• A public member may serve more than six consecutive years by a two-thirds vote of Council.
