- On 2018 April 23, Council approved a Public Engagement Approach to be undertaken by an Engagement Advisory Sub-Committee, such program to "reflect the diverse and varied interests of Calgarians and key stakeholders" and confirmed that the purpose of the program is to:
 - "inform and educate the public about the bid process;
 - seek public input into whether or not Calgary should submit a bid; and
 - identify issues, concerns and opportunities for stakeholders of a potential bid and respond to questions".
