TERMS OF REFERENCE

To make recommendations to City Council through the SPC on Community & Protective Services on policy and systems issues impacting people with disabilities. To be a resource to City Council and City Administration in addressing physical, transportation, communication, social and economic accessibility issues to provide a high level of accessibility for people with physical, sensory and cognitive disabilities.

COMPOSITION

Total Membership: 13

Appointed/nominated by Council: 13

Approved by the Advisory Committee: 13

- six members with disabilities representing a range of people with physical, sensory and cognitive disabilities
- one member representing the seniors community
- three citizens-at-large members who may or may not have a disability, but who are interested in access issues
- three members of City Administration (e.g., Planning & Development, Calgary Transit and Calgary Recreation)

TERM

- 2 years terms (Subsequent terms would be staggered)
- A public member may serve a maximum of six consecutive years.
- Despite the above, a public member may serve until his or her successor is appointed. The service of a member beyond the appointed term shall not count toward the limit on the length of service set out above if the additional service is one year or less.
- When an appointment is made to fill a public member vacancy:
 - If the balance of the term to be served is one year or less, that service shall not count toward the limit on the length of service; and
 - If the balance of the term to be served is more than one year, that service shall count toward the limit on the length of service.
- A public member may serve more than six consecutive years by a two-thirds vote of Council.
