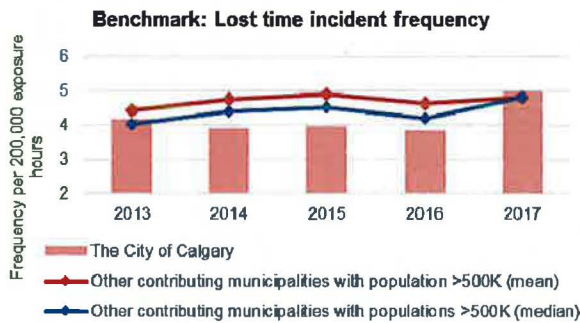




Health and Safety Benchmarking

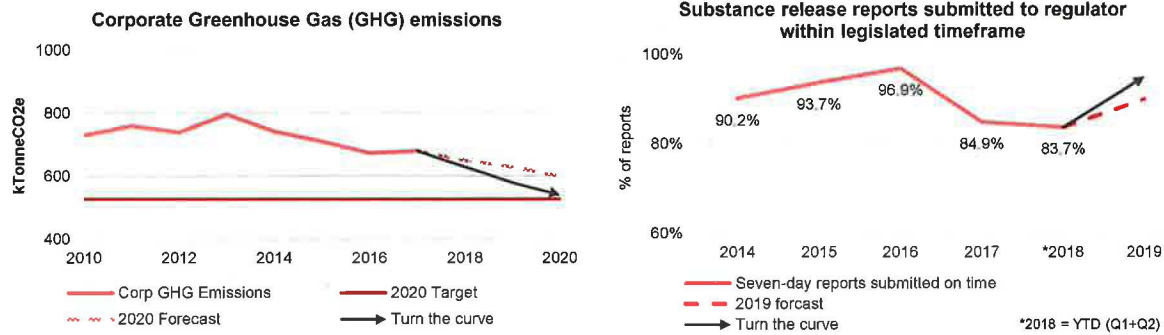

Environmental Outreach
