Children make new friends, learn games and participate in activities that they can use on their path to healthy and active lifestyles. Community Play Day This event provides people in the community with opportunities to connect, play, enjoy and deepen friendships while adding vibrancy to local neighbourhood life and increasing social resilience. Lawn Chair Theatre This family-friendly event encourages people to come together and enjoy community life, while deepening connections and friendships. These relationships add to the vibrancy of local community life, and contribute to a friendly neighbourhood. Youth Drop-In Gym Program This program is an opportunity for youth to develop new skills and friendships while participating in activities. It allows them to deepen their connections to those around them. This increases social resiliency and develops a sense of investment and ownership in the community. Pickle Ball Program This free program brings people together and provides an opportunity for neighbours to connect and recreate while building upon their sense of involvement in a vibrant neighbourhood. Older Adult Yoga Program This free program brings people together and provides an opportunity for neighbours to connect and recreate while building upon their sense of involvement in a vibrant neighbourhood. Pickle Ball Courts added to Tennis Courts This enhancement provides a space for people to gather, connect, and recreate. The new public space contributes to residents' senses of involvement in a vibrant neighbourhood. Tree Planting Additional trees increase the urban forest tree canopy and contribute to a sense of place and neighbourhood pride. Additional Park Benches Park benches allow residents to utilize parks and greenspaces for social activities. These neighbourhood gathering places foster social cohesion and enhance community resiliency.	Community Events Neighbourhood events enhance the enjoyment of community life, and increase social resiliency. Community Mural The addition of art that is representative of the neighbourhood in public places helps to build neighbourhood identity, while adding to its vibrancy.
