## Re: Designation of the Riviera Apartments as a Municipal Historic Resource

The Calgary Heritage Authority (CHA), in accordance with its role to advise Council and Administration on heritage matters in the City of Calgary, would like to take this opportunity to support the designation of the Riviera Apartments, located in the Beltline, as a Municipal Historic Resource.

The Riviera Apartments is listed on the CHA *Inventory of Evaluated Historic Resources* as a Community Historic Resource.

The Riviera Apartments, constructed in 1954, is a three-storey, 19-unit brick apartment building designed in a vernacular Modernist style. Organized in a U-shaped plan, it features a simple rectilinear form and appearance, with subtle decorative accents in brickwork. The Riviera is a quality, well-preserved example of its style and scale in the community of Beltline.
