Access to Water

City of Calgary BYLAW NUMBER 20M2003

Clause 14. No Person shall enter, wade, swim or skate in, or upon any body of water which flows through, is adjacent to or is located within a Park unless such activity is specifically allowed by the Director pursuant to this Bylaw.



Crown Ownership of Shorelands

"In Alberta, the province owns most of the beds and shores of all naturally occurring lakes, rivers and streams."

Public Access to Public Water Bodies
"Access to the beds and shores of a river, stream, lake or other body of water is subject to legal access."

"The beds and shores of a river or stream that are bounded by private land may generally be traversed below the ordinary high water mark without fear of trespass."
