BACKGROUND

The FCC is a non-profit umbrella organization, registered in 1961 to assist community associations to enhance their effectiveness in planning and administering their associations. The organization's membership includes 122 of the approximately 131 associations in the city. Current services include financial and accounting support, community planning, organizational development and support, community advocacy, and availability of a database, website, information and historical files.

PURPOSE

The previous Operating Agreement between The City of Calgary and FCC expired on 2003, December 31. The new Operating Agreement reflects a change in FCC reporting requirements. The new Operating Agreement clearly outlines the desired outcomes and success indicators for the grant provided.

The outcomes were jointly determined in consultation with the FCC Board of Directors and staff and are in alignment with the FCC Strategic Goals 2003 – 2005 which have been approved by the Presidents Council for community associations. The FCC is requested to report yearly on their success in achieving the defined outcomes. These results will be considered in the deliberation of future funding.
