


Capitol Hill Traffic Safety Issues (Nov 2018)

Based on community feedback from the This Is My Neighbourhood program (2015) and the Living Lab 20th Ave NW (2016), the Capitol Hill Community Association is requesting the City's attention to the following safety issues:

- 1 Bicycle Facilities along East/West Connectors
 - Cycle tracks along 20 Av N provide safe east/west connection to existing 10 St bike lane and to shops/schools
 - Bike lanes along 24 Av N provide safe east/west connection to high schools and University of Calgary
- 2 Sidewalks Added
 - Missing sidewalk on North side of Capitol Hill School (South side of 22 Av N)
 - No sidewalks on 16A, 17 & 17A Streets W, North of 25 Av N
- 3 Flashing Beacon Crosswalks
 - 24 Av N at 15 St and 17 St W– These are dangerous crossing areas used by many to access Confederation Park and neighbourhoods north of 24 Av N, especially during the Festival of Lights
 - 14 St W at 21 Av N Trying to cross four lanes of fast-moving traffic at this crosswalk is near impossible and very dangerous
 - 20 Av N at 12 St W- This crosswalk is used by many SAIT students & families accessing Confederation Park
 - 10 St W at 18 Av N A crosswalk is needed for pedestrians to connect bus stops on either side of 10 St
- 4 Traffic Calming Along 18 Av N Between 10 & 14 St W
 - This route has significant cut-through traffic with fast-moving vehicles due to having no stop signs or traffic calming measures
- 5 Closure of Vehicle Access to Community
 - Cut-through traffic enters community from 16 Av N via 11 St W, should be closed off similar to 13, 15 & 17 Streets W
