



### **Scope** • Gap analysis and research

- Review and updates
  - maps (Urban Structure, Primary Transit and Road and Street Network, etcetera), typologies and other Plan terminology
- Incorporate new and emerging topics
- Review monitoring and reporting system
  - current city-wide targets and core indicators
- Revision to incorporate updated legislation
- Alignment between Plans
- Recommend and prepare updates





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### Phase 1

Technical Review and Research (Q4 2018 to Q4 2019)

- > Establish the current state of the Plans
- Identify what the future state should be
- Research analysis to establish context of the review

## Deliver:

- *Recommendations on Plans updates*
- Workplan and budget to implement recommendations



#### Phase 2

Update the Plans (Q4 2019 to Q4 2020)

Dependent on Council's direction from Phase 1

Deliver:

- o Updated joint Plan
- o Brought forward to Committee no later than Q4 2020



## **Engagement Approach**

- Iterative and Responsive
- Inclusive: Opportunities for diverse stakeholders
- > Multiple opportunities to provide input
- Stakeholder input helps the project team better understand the values, interests, expectations, and priorities



#### Recommendation

That the Standing Policy Committee of Planning and Urban Development recommend Council direct Administration to:

- Undertake the review work of the Municipal Development Plan and Calgary Transportation Plan in accordance with the scope identified in Attachment 1; and,
- II. Return with the outcomes of Phase 1 to Council through the Standing Policy Committee on Planning and Urban Development no later than Q4 2019.
