Some Social Service Car Programs in USA

Cars are important for employment because they are so much faster and more flexible than any other form of transportation. Planners in <u>Cincinnati</u> found that most people in that region could reach 80 to 100 percent of the region's jobs with a twenty-minute drive, but could only reach 20 to 40 percent of the region's jobs with a forty-minute transit trip. The Cincinnati study also found that building rail transit would actually reduce the mobility of low-income residents, without increasing anyone else' mobility.


