

PROPOSED

BYLAW NUMBER 4M2019

BEING A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF CALGARY TO TRANSFER ENVIRONMENTAL RESERVE TO THE CROWN

WHEREAS The City of Calgary has agreed to transfer the environmental reserve, as identified below, to the Crown for the completion of the West Ring Road;

WHEREAS the provisions of sections 676(1) and 676(1)(b) of the <u>Municipal Government Act</u>, R.S.A. 2000, c. M-26 as amended, with respect to the disposition of environmental reserve have been complied with, and

AND WHEREAS the provisions of Sections 230 and 606 of the <u>Municipal Government</u> <u>Act</u>, R.S.A. 2000, c. M-26 as amended, with respect to notice of intention of Council to pass such a Bylaw have been complied with;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CALGARY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

Upon passage of the Bylaw, transfer documents shall be submitted to the Alberta Land
Titles Office and the following described environmental reserve parcels shall be cancelled
and the registrar shall transfer ownership to the Crown and issue any new certificates of
title as required:

Block 4

Lot 13ER

Excepting thereout all mines and minerals

Plan 0813514

Block 6

Lot 8ER (Environmental Reserve)

Excepting thereout all mines and minerals

Area: 2.747 Hectares (6.79 Acres) More or Less

Described as:

All that portion of lot 8ER, block 6 as shown on plan 0813514 which lies within Area N as shown on plan 0313106

Containing 0.076 hectares (0.19 acres more or less)

2. The proper officers of The City of Calgary are hereby authorized to execute such instruments as may be necessary to effect the purpose of the Bylaw.



3. This Bylaw comes into force on the date it is passed.
