



- We Object to the approval of these bylaws that will allow a development to flood Brodylo Farms land
- This development fails to accommodate or preserve the pre-existing and interconnected drainage network which will result in the planned and extensive flooding of Brodylo Farms upstream lands.




3-D color hillshade rendering of surface topography showing the current wetlands and drainage courses that are interconnected with the Dream development application

## Providence SMDP proposes that without a functioning culvert under 53<sup>rd</sup> ST water will drain north 4.5 meters uphill before continuing downhill




Providence SMDP incorrectly states that there is no drainage courses in the study area and that the Dream development functions in isolation.


Drainage course has been impounded by 53<sup>rd</sup> St




## Impact on Brodylo Farms

- Blockage of the natural drainage course at the culvert caused substantial flood damage to Brodylo Farms
- Resulted in a loss 28 acres of viable farm land
- Due to erosion and recent sediment buildup while the culvert was plugged, the wetland may never again drain as it would naturally
- Erosional flood plain is now infested with an abundance of noxious weeds, including Canada thistle and field sow thistle
