RE: SUPPORT FOR INTERMUNICIPAL OPIOID RESPONSE ACP GRANT APPLICATION

WHEREAS the opioid crisis is a problem affecting municipalities of all sizes and types in Alberta;

AND WHEREAS although the opioid crisis is a public health issue, it strains civic resources nonetheless, including emergency first responders, transit, housing, parks, planning, and many more;

AND WHEREAS as individual communities tackle this issue they generate knowledge and practices that could benefit others;

AND WHEREAS there is a lack of a coordinated, formalized approach to transferring this knowledge between municipalities;

AND WHEREAS the City of Grande Prairie is submitting an Alberta Community Partnership (ACP) grant application for funds to enable the development of a coordinated Intermunicipal Opioid Response to address the gap;

AND WHEREAS the program is expected to be funded by the ACP grant with in-kind operational support provided by the City of Grande Prairie.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT COUNCIL** endorse the City of Grande Prairie's application for an Alberta Community Partnership grant for the development of an Alberta Intermunicipal Opioid Response.
