




# Calgary Recap of Work Completed

### Since June 2017:

- Engaged stakeholders
- Researched best practices within BC, Toronto, and Ottawa
- Co-designed a recommended operating model
- Mapped business processes
- Investigated potential IT solutions
- Implemented two "quick wins"





## Calgary One Window Recommendation

## The proposed One Window entity will:

- Be a separate non-profit organization
- Manage the client intake process across participating housing providers
- Be independently staffed
- Be supported by an IT system

## One Window will improve the housing system by:



Transforming how Calgarians access non-market housing



Utilizing existing non-market housing stock more efficiently



Providing new citywide data and analytics



Improving sector collaboration



Creating efficiencies for housing providers



Replacing manual intake processes with modernized technology

# Requested funding for One Window from the Government of Alberta:



Estimated Implementation Costs (One-time funding for 2019-2021)

\$7.5M



Annual Operating Costs
(Ongoing funding beginning in 2022)

\$3.0M

Assuming funding is received in April 2019, One Window will launch 2021.



#### **ADMINISTRATION RECOMMENDATION:**

That the Priorities and Finance Committee recommend that Council:

- 1. Advocate to the Government of Alberta, Ministry of Seniors and Housing by writing a letter requesting funding for implementation and on-going operational funding for the One Window initiative; and,
- 2. Pending program funding and approval by The Government of Alberta, direct Administration to continue leading the implementation and transition of the One Window initiative with the non-profit housing community until the new entity is operational.
