Proposed Amendments to Land Use Bylaw 1P2007

- 1. The City of Calgary Land Use Bylaw, being Bylaw 1P2007 of the City of Calgary, as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:
 - (a) Insert the following after subsection 44 (8):
 - **44 (8.1)** Notwithstanding 44 (8) (a), the *General Manager* may grant a request to extend the date before which *development* must commence for a change of *use* to a **Cannabis Store** solely for the purposes of accommodating a moratorium on the issuance of licenses from Province, provided:
 - (a) no more than two extensions are granted for any *development permit*;
 - (b) the length of the extension is up to one year;
 - (c) the request is made in writing on a form approved by the *General Manager* and must be submitted with the fee as prescribed by resolution of *Council*; and
 - (d) the request is granted prior to the *development permit* lapsing.
 - (8.2) Subsection (8.1) remains in effect until December 31, 2021.
- 2. The Bylaw comes into force on 2019 April 29.
