LETTER FROM CEO & CHAIR

Sport Calgary enjoyed continued successful growth in 2018. Our new 2019-23 Strategic Plan has been approved by the Board and will set our course for the next five years.

We have continued to strengthen our governance model, with full implementation of a Standing Committee structure. Several new policies and tools are in place that will promote good governance in the years ahead. Of note, we expanded our Board of Directors to a maximum of twelve directors. The Board also improved its internal risk management frameworks, updated its Standing Committee mandates, and introduced new policies relating to information privacy.

This year is notable for being the final full year as Chair for Perry Cavanagh, who has served on our Board of Directors since 2011. Over the past nine years Sport Calgary has transformed from a small group of sport enthusiasts into an official Civic Partner of the City of Calgary, representing over 200 sport member organizations throughout the city. Our Board's focus on good governance, leadership, and innovation has allowed Sport Calgary's potential to be more fully realized in recent years. The development of our new 2019-23 Strategic Plan will ensure that Sport Calgary keeps a focus on future results in the years ahead.

In 2018, we continued to improve our financial results and event attendance, including our signature All Sport events. A new digital platform is in place, ready to tell the exciting stories of our members, with additional staff resources managing this expanding content.

Sport Calgary advocated for many important causes over the past year. This included the support for a new multisport Fieldhouse at Foothills Athletic Park, improved safety measures for women in Canadian sport, and broad civic investment in community-level infrastructure. We assisted with the Special Olympics Provincial Games, Red Deer 2019 Canada Games, Calgary 2026 Bid Corporation, Respect Group, and local Indigenous schools.

Our sport engagement activities are led by Catriona Le May Doan, whose sport leadership in the community is reflective of Sport Calgary's mission of assisting, supporting, and influencing the growth of sport.

2018 will also be remembered as the year that the new Sport for Life Policy was unanimously approved by Calgary City Council. This progressive new policy delivers a mandate to Sport Calgary to support Calgary Recreation in designing and delivering sport programs and initiatives, building infrastructure, and allocating amenity use. We have a defined role to build the capacity of local sport organizations through education, training, and best practices, as well as lead a community advisory committee.

Sport Calgary is proud of our work with community partners to promote sport as part of a larger community. This includes work with local school boards, PLAY Calgary, facility advisory groups, Comrie's Sports Equipment Bank, KidSport, Dare to Care, Respect Group, and others. We continue to promote an understanding of Canadian Sport for Life, a framework to engage education, health, sport and recreation sectors with the goal of improving the quality of sport and physical activity for all Canadians.

Our organization acts as a central resource to the sport community, functioning as a liaison and facilitator for connections between sport organizations in Calgary. Sport organizations are also able to contact Sport Calgary for assistance with grant applications and governance best practices, including organizational bylaws. We have a zero-tolerance stance on sexual harassment, bullying, and discrimination in sport.

We will continue working closely with the City, our members, and all stakeholders in advocating for sport in 2019.

CELEBRATION OF SPORT

Calgary's Celebration of Sport honours the countless athletes, coaches, parents, volunteers, facilities, sport organizations, and businesses that make Calgary an incredible sport city.

This year's event at WinSport saw over 500 people attend an afternoon' reception hosted by Catriona Le May Doan. In addition to an expert panel, attendees were treated to presentations and discussions on current sport issues in the city, including the November plebiscite vote on an Olympic and Paralympic Games bid and the Red Deer 2019 Canada Games.

RON SOUTHERN BUSINESS AND SPORT AWARD

CALGARY SPORTS AND ENTERTAINMENT CORPORATION (CSEC)

CSEC has been a tireless supporter of health and wellness, amateur and grassroots sports, and education initiatives. Since 2000, over \$36 million has been invested back into southern Alberta communities by the Calgary Flames Foundation.

SPORT LEADERSHIP AWARD

CALGARY MINOR SOCCER ASSOCIATION (CMSA)

As the governing body of youth soccer in Calgary, Calgary Minor Soccer Association exists to support its member clubs as well as provide opportunities for all participants in a fun, safe and inclusive environment.

RESEARCH

This year, Sport Calgary commissioned the *Economic Significance of Amateur Sport in Calgary* report as a key piece of civic research, in partnership with Tourism Calgary and the City of Calgary. This report, authored by Caminata Consulting, is valuable as a credible reference point when considering important reviews and public decisions. This includes decisions involving municipal sport policies, capital and operating budgets, and ongoing legacies from sporting events. It is hoped this report will directly lead to higher community involvement in sport and more accessible sport opportunities for all Calgarians.

KEY FINDINGS

\$1.2 BILLION

The Gross Municipal Amateur Sport Product in Calgary, which represents the sum of expenditures such as private household consumption, various levels of government spending, balance of trade, and other private capital investments.

\$1.1 BILLION

The **overall GDP impact** on the Calgary economy of these expenditures; amateur sport supported almost 1.0% of Calgary's GDP.

\$750 MILLION

The **overall impact on wages & salaries** on the Calgary economy of these expenditures; amateur sport supported almost 2.3% of Calgary's employment.

While contributing to amateur sport in Calgary, volunteers provided an estimated 15 million hours.

15 MILLION HOURS

Amateur sport spending had an effect on employment in Calgary of almost 17,000 full-time jobs in 2016.

17,000 HOURS

Sport Calgary also continues to use and promote the *Sport Facility Supply and Demand Study*, a comprehensive survey of facilities across Calgary, with a planned update in the next few years.
