Recommendation

That the Intergovernmental Affairs Committee recommend Council to direct Administration, in support of The City of Calgary's commitment to the Truth and Reconciliation Calls to Action, to:

- 1. Scope out and identify the resources needed to support Protocol Agreements with Nations;
- Begin with scoping and identifying the resources for a Protocol Agreement in response to the request made through the Mayor's Office 2023 November 16 by the Blackfoot Confederacy; and
- 3. Report back to Council on the results of the scoping work and the resources required through the Intergovernmental Affairs Committee no later than the end of Q2, 2024.



Highlights

Protocol (Relationship) Agreements:

- Framework of cooperation on areas that impact social, environmental and economic areas (but not limited to):
 - Housing
 - Mental Health, Addictions, and Opioid Crisis
 - Economic Development
 - Culture and Tourism
 - Reconciliation
- Need to be consistent with Municipal Government Act, Alberta Law and Canadian Constitution.
- Aligns with White Goose Flying Report's Call to Action
 - Creating conditions of mutual respect and sustained collaboration (Action #45.iii)
